The Radisson room rates for standard king or queen room, single or double occupancy, is \$119.00, plus tax (approximately 12.25%). These special NARFE room rates will be available on June 25th until June30th. The Radisson has blocked 10 rooms for the Conference. Reservations should be made directly with the hotel prior to Saturday 5:00 p.m. on June 15th. Guests are only charged for one night if they cancel within 24 hours prior to honoring reservation.. After the cutoff date, it is at the hotel’s discretion whether to accept additional reservations that will be subject to the prevailing rates and availability. Let them know you have a block code **1906NARFEC** for reservations. If you are physically challenged, be specific about your needs when making your reservations.

The amenities in the room include WiFi, coffee maker, hair dryer, clock radio, full size iron/ironing board, option for room service, and desk with chair. You can also enjoy one on-site full-service restaurant, heated pool, Jacuzzi, fitness center, complimentary business center, complimentary shuttle service within 5 miles of property, and full-service lounge/bar. Ample free parking is available.

Conference Registration: Members and guests attending the Conference must complete the attached registration form (**one person per form**).


