PARKING, TRANSPORTATION, AND DOWNTOWN INDIANAPOLIS RESTAURANTS/EVENTS/SPORTS

I have provided information about parking at the Hyatt Regency Indianapolis for those who will be driving. The Hyatt Regency Indianapolis has both valet and self-parking options available at the hotel.

Self-parking:

Day and overnight self-parking is available on an hourly basis, currently priced at \$42 for 24 hours. Please note that self-parking cannot be charged to guest rooms and must be paid either at a kiosk or upon exiting by credit card only. It's important to note that you are required to pay every time you re-enter the garage.

Valet parking:

Overnight valet parking is available for standard-sized vehicles at a discounted rate of \$55. For oversized vehicles, the rate is \$62. Valet charges can be added to guest room accounts, and drivers are permitted to leave and re-enter the hotel premises at no extra cost.

I wanted to share some important details regarding transportation from the airport to the host hotel (Hyatt Regency Indianapolis, 1 South Capitol Avenue, Indianapolis, IN; Tel: 317-632-1234) and dining, shopping, and city-related events you may be interested in.

TRANSPORTATION AT INDIANAPOLIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

For those flying in, there are several options available:

- 1. **Hotel Shuttle:** The Hyatt does not provide transportation service from or to the airport.
- 2. **Ride-Sharing Services:** Both Uber and Lyft operate in the area and are convenient options. You can easily book a ride upon arrival at the airport. When using these services, exit the terminal to the Ground Transportation Center that is located on the first floor of the Terminal Garage. - 3. **Taxi Services:** Taxis are available at the airport 24/7. To hail a taxi, please go to the Taxi Station on the lower level of the terminal just outside of Baggage Claim and press the green call button. It's important to note there's a minimum charge of \$15 for all fares from the airport, regardless of the distance. - 5. **Public transportation:** IndyGo is a local bus service with over 30 fixed routes within the city. Day passes and single ride options are available. The cost for an all-day pass is \$4. The cost for a single ride is \$1.75 (exact cash only if paying on the bus). IndyGo's Route 8 service the closest stop (Maryland St & Missouri St) to the hotel (roughly 7 minutes walking distance). To catch IndyGo Bus Route 8 Meijer E. Washington from the airport, please go the Ground transportation Center.
